Les Moore, ND, MSOM, DHANP, CCH, RH, LAc. is a pioneer and one of the world's leaders of Integrative Medicine, being the only Naturopathic Doctor, Homeopath, and Licensed Acupuncturist to have served as Director of two Integrative Medicine Centers and be employed in two hospitals. He has authored two leading books on healing and continues to write and lecture internationally.

Dr. Moore received a Doctor of Naturopathic Medicine, a Master of Science in Oriental Medicine, and a Certificate of Homeopathy from the National College of Naturopathic Medicine in Portland, Oregon. He is a New York State licensed acupuncturist and is Board Certified by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine. He has also earned a Master of Arts in Applied Theology and a Graduate Certificate in Interfaith Pastoral and Spiritual Care from Marylhurst University in Marylhurst, Oregon.

Dr. Moore currently serves as the Director of Integrative Medicine at Clifton Springs Hospital and Clinic in Clifton Springs, New York.

History

The American Academy of Homeopathy (AAH) is located at Clifton Springs Hospital and Clinic in Clifton Springs, New York.



Clifton Springs Hospital was originally started as a homeopathic and water cure sanitarium in 1850 by Henry Foster MD, a pioneer in the use of homeopathy and integrative medicine. The AAH continues in this historical tradition and is led by Dr. Les Moore, ND, DHANP, CCH, RH, LAc. and Kim Moore, D.Hom.

Diploma Program Structure

AAH is a three-year comprehensive diploma program that has a unique modular design. This modular design allows students to matriculate at anytime, starting classes at any point in the program. The program is divided into nine core classes that are divided into three parts over three years. Each core class is a stand-alone module. The last year of the program includes clinical experience. The



culmination of the three-year program is a Diploma of Homeopathy.

Classes are scheduled once a month for a Friday night/Saturday session. This allows students the flexibility to take the program while not interrupting their work or family life.

Prospective Students

This program is designed for individuals desiring to be professional homeopaths and health care providers who wish to incorporate homeopathy into their practice. The program is geared toward graduates being able to be nationally certified with the Council for Homeopathic Certification to become a Certified Classical Homeopath (CCH).

Botanical Medicine Institute

Founded by Dr. Les Moore, ND, MSOM, DHANP, CCH, RH, LAc., the Botanical Medicine Institute (BMI) offers a uniquely structured one-year certificate program of class work that allows students to begin their studies at any point in the yearly class cycle. The certificate program draws mainly from Western botanical medicine, but also examines the expanding pharmacopeia of global herbal medicine traditions.

Upon completion of the certificate program, students will receive a certificate and may elect to continue their studies with an apprenticeship with Dr. Moore and BMI herbalists. Upon completion of the apprenticeship program, each student receives an Advanced Botanical Medicine certificate.

Students may also elect to take single classes as opposed to the entire year program.

BMI is located at the Clifton Springs Hospital & Clinic in the historic village of Clifton Springs, New York, which has been a center of healing and health care traditions for more than 150 years. Botanical Medicine Institute is proud to continue and expand upon these rich traditions.
